Our presenter this month is Warren Beddell. Warren's program is titled "Elements and Principles of Design." There are times when a snapshot is all we're looking for. But, for most of us, most of the time, as photographers, we're working to create an image. That's where composition comes in—a set of guidelines that have served artists well for hundreds, if not thousands, of years. In this program we will explore the elements of design, as well as some principles for using them to improve our photographs. Whether it's a nature shot or a landscape, a portrait or an abstract, all photographs have a composition, and understanding the elements and principles of design can help us appreciate and control that composition for better images.

#### **BIO**

Warren has been interested in photography since his first Brownie with black-and-white film as a child. While in the Air Force in Spain in the late 1960's, he picked up his first 35mm camera. However, it was two years of intensive study at the Southeastern Center for the Arts in Atlanta, Georgia, in 1989 – 1990 that was the turning point in his vision. Studying the elements of composition and design, he was rewarded with superior images. Shooting in urban Atlanta lead Warren to architectural subjects, and close-ups in particular. The lines and textures of the buildings, old and new, offered many opportunities.

After more than a decade away from the viewfinder, Warren resumed his photography in August of 2004, switching to the digital format. Today Warren shoots with digital SLRs and processes in the digital darkroom. Having also worked in a chemical black-and-white darkroom, he appreciates the wide range of options available today. As a resident of Brevard, North Carolina, Warren continues to find even greater opportunities to explore his vision of photography in the architecture and nature of Western North Carolina, which offers an unlimited palette of patterns and textures.

## LEWIS KEMPER WORKSHOP WEEKEND

SANP is pleased to announce that Canon "Explorer of Light" Lewis Kemper will be presenting a workshop weekend for us on Saturday and Sunday, May 14 & 15, 2011. Each day will be a distinctly different workshop.

On Saturday, May 14, Lewis will be presenting a free classroom workshop, sponsored by Canon, in the Goins Auditorium at Pellissippi State Technical Community College. Even though this workshop is free to attend, you must pre-register and there is a limit of 150 people (capacity of Goins Auditorium). Lunch will be offered at the PSTCC Cafeteria for \$20 per person and pre-registration is required. You are not required to buy lunch at PSTCC, but it is recommended due to convenience and possible time

constraints in a workshop format. Registration for lunch is required at the time you register for the workshop, and checks should be made to SANP.

On Sunday, May 15 Lewis will lead a hands-on field workshop in Great Smoky Mountains NP. This workshop will be limited to 20 participants and will cost \$75 per person. Registration is on a first come basis and payment is required at time of registration. You must attend the Saturday, May 14 workshop to be eligible to attend the Sunday, May 15 workshop.
