NOVEMBER MONTHLY MEETING

Date: Tuesday, November 29, 2011

Time: Social time 6:30pm/Meeting 7:00pm

Location: Goins Auditorium, Pellissippi State Technical Community College

For our program this month we will be presenting some of the most stunning images on the planet... YOURS! Once again we will be having a critique of images submitted by the membership. So each of you get to choose what will be included in the program. We will have a three-person panel of critics who will channel your "oohs" and "ahhs" into constructive feedback.

The judges will spend as much time as possible reviewing as many of the submitted images as possible. Not all images will necessarily be critiqued, depending on the number of submissions and time. Judges will be giving honest, non-biased feedback. If you submit, please be open to hearing constructive criticism. Feedback will be as positive as possible. Images will remain anonymous during the show.

Each member may submit up to three images for the critique. We will arrange the images so that all of the number 1 images will be shown, then all of the number 2 images, and finally all of the number 3 images. This way every photographer will hopefully have at least two images critiqued, and possible three if we have enough time.

The meeting will start with some discussion on the new and hopefully simplified categories. There will also be discussion on the new and hopefully simplified preparation of your projected images.

The format in which to send them is going to be the same as submitting images to 2012 SANP Salon. This will also be great practice in getting your images ready. The guidelines below are the new ones. If it is not mentioned below, it should not matter how you do it.

1. File names should be in the following format:

lastname_firstname_classification_category_number

(e.g., Smith_John_1_Scenic_1).

- 2. Place the following information in the IPTC metadata of the image.**
 - a. Under Title/Document Title, write the title of your image**
 - b. Under Creator/Author, write your name in the following format:**
 - Lastname, firstname (e.g., Smith, John).
 - i. Click [here](#) for a video on how to do this in Lightroom.
 - ii. Click [here](#) for a video on how to do this in Photoshop.
 - iii. Click [here](#) for a video on how to do this in Elements.

Make sure you do not strip the metadata out later in your workflow. If you don't know what this means, don't worry as the defaults will keep everything correct.

All submissions must be received by November 25, 2011.

The videos might take a little while to load depending on your internet speed - please be patient. No entry forms will be need with the projected images. All images will be displayed on a sRGB 1024x768 projector.
