### **ROD PLANCK WORKSHOP WEEKEND**

SANP is pleased to announce that veteran nature photographer Rod Planck will be presenting a workshop weekend for us on Saturday and Sunday, April 14 & 15, 2012. Each day will be a distinctly different workshop.

On Saturday, April 14 Rod will be presenting a classroom workshop in the Goins Auditorium at Pellissippi State Technical Community College. We have asked Rod to tailor this presentation to concentrate on photographic vision and image capture. This workshop is limited to 150 people (capacity of Goins Auditorium). Southern Appalachian Nature Photographers (SANP) is pleased to present a workshop by veteran nature photographer Rod Planck on Saturday, April 14, 2012 in Knoxville, Tennessee.

Rod's classroom workshop will be held in the Goins Auditorium on the Hardin Valley campus of Pellissippi State Technical Community College (PSTCC). This workshop will be limited to 150 people (capacity of Goins Auditorium).
