Our presenter this month is SANP charter member Ken Jenkins. For those of you who might be relatively new to SANP, Ken was extremely instrumental in the formation and development of SANP in the early 1990's. After many years of photographing wildlife and scenes in nature, Ken accepted a project a few years ago that has paralleled his outdoor interests and even complimented his efforts to see and record new areas and their wildlife. An offer to develop a portfolio of cowboy and horses of North America has opened a new door to seeing and refining images of the Old West and the lifestyle of the cowboy. From Texas to Montana, South Dakota to Oklahoma, Ken has spent extended periods of time on well-established ranches recording everything from cow camps and brandings to tack rooms and character of cowboy portraits.

His presentation to SANP is original in content and will hopefully inspire a new look at the Old West in color, black and white, and hand-colored images. The intent might possibly be to say "no matter how long you have photographed, there is always a new area that can excite and refresh your eye and make you better at everything else you do." Ken's appreciation for SANP and his admiration for SANP members assure that this will be a fun and open conversation from an "old hand at loving his trade."

BIO

Ken Jenkins is a charter member of SANP and resides in Gatlinburg. For the past 35 years he has earned 100% of his income as a professional nature photographer. His galleries in Gatlinburg, Beneath the Smoke and Heaven's Eyes have been in existence for 30 and 12 years respectively. He spends his year photographing for corporate clients, speaking using his photography to illustrate his messages, operating the whole-sale end of the business, and printing and supervising the operation of the retail stores.

Ken's approach to photography has always been a bit different, with the philosophy that he must never "lose the wonder" and that there is opportunity to help and encourage others in recording the natural world. Recently, he wrote an article concerning the joy of being an individual in photography and the danger of getting caught in the trap of unhealthy competition.

All photographs must be original and created by the submitting photographer.

A maximum of four (4) photographs is allowed per photographer.

The judge's decisions are final.
