With over 375,000 images in his files, his photographs have appeared on greeting cards, calendars, magazines, posters, murals, fine art prints, brochures, and advertising. His credits include such notable publications as National Geographic, Outdoor Photographer and Time Magazine. Byron has had over 11,000 images published and more than 18,000 prints installed worldwide. He is currently represented by 4 stock agencies worldwide.
