Recommended equipment:

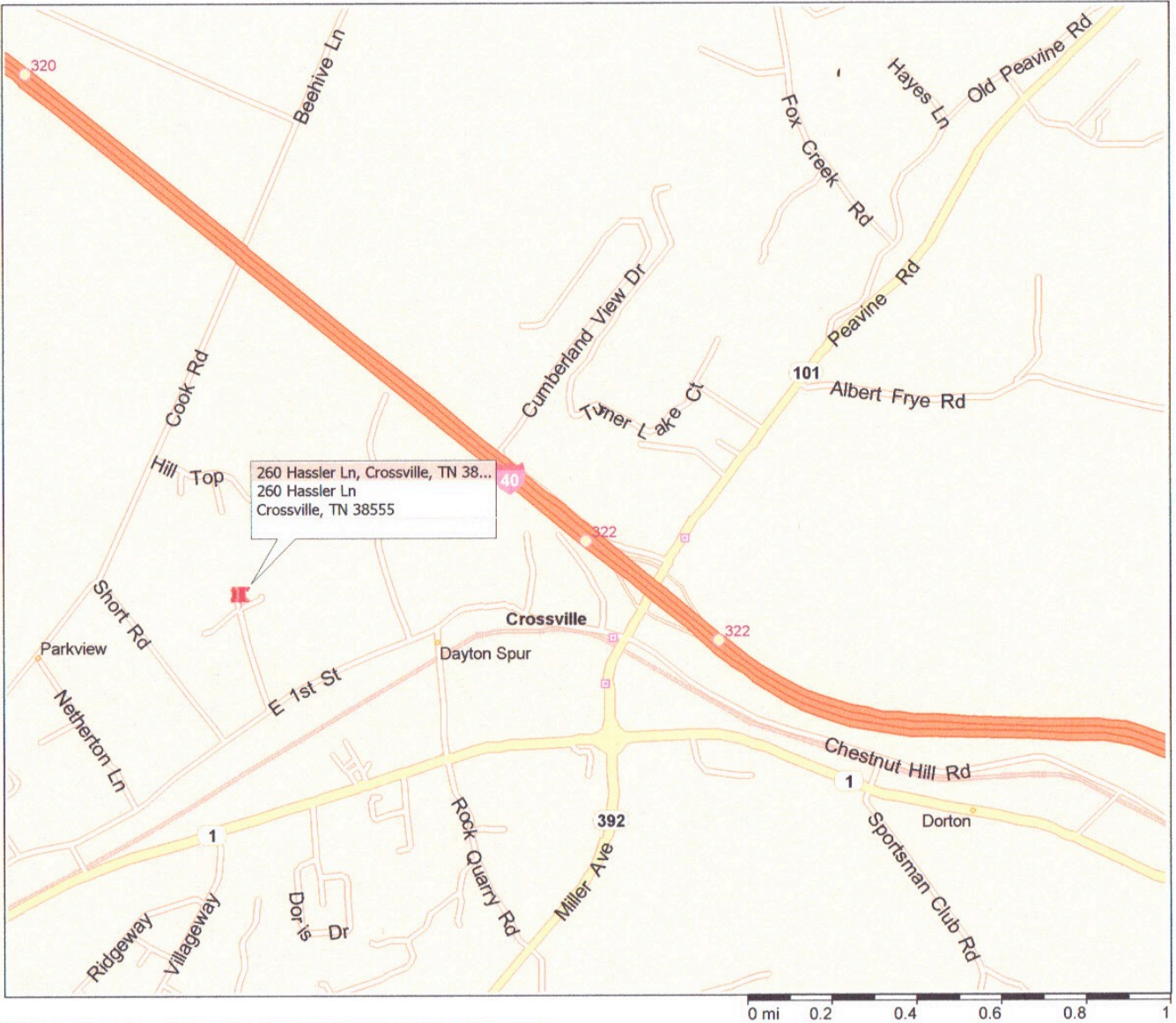
Macro lenses or other equipment and accessories for making close-up photos.
