Our presenter this month is Bill Campbell. His program is based on his new eBook, *Areas Overlooked -- East Tennessee Wilderness: A Taste*.

The Great Smoky Mountains NP gets lots of visitors and lots of attention, with photographers from all over the world coming to the park to photograph. At times it gets crowded (recall the last time you were at Cades Cove before sunrise in the spring or fall with about 50 cars in line). Now imagine all the beauty and diversity offered by the Smokies, but with almost no one else around.

He will talk about alternative places to photograph in East Tennessee, including the Cumberland Plateau and the Cherokee NF. Leading photo tours and teaching workshops since 1997, Bill is an accomplished photographer with numerous magazine and book credits to his name. His published books are the widely acclaimed *Smoky Mountains Photographer's Guide* and *Cumberland Odyssey: A Journey in Pictures and Words along Tennessee's Cumberland Trail and Plateau*, and his newest book, *Areas Overlooked East Tennessee Wilderness: A Taste*, available as a free iBook from the Apple Bookstore. Trained as a biologist, he brings his love of the natural world to his workshops. He is also a physician specializing in Wilderness Medicine and is a Fellow of the Academy of Wilderness Medicine. With varied interests, his photography is always pushing the boundaries of capture and expression. He currently serves on the Board of the North American Nature Photography Association (NANPA) as the past president.
