Through this presentation, you will be able to know when and where to best utilize your time in the Smokies. As the most visited National Park in the US, there are no “secret” locations but there are better times and methods that most photographers visiting the Smokies may not be aware of. All images in the presentation are clearly identified as to location and date to assist you in planning your Autumn and Winter visits to the Smokies.

Roger Trentham is an eighth generation native of the Smoky Mountains. Having grown up in the Roaring Fork area of Gatlinburg, Roger spent many hours in the Great Smoky Mountains National Park from an early age. Taking up photography in his early twenties, Roger has explored and photographed the mountains in all their seasons and moods. Through leading workshops, camera club outings and presentations and having his photographs featured in magazine articles, he is more than happy to showcase this beautiful part of the world.

### **OBED WILD AND SCENIC RIVER**

Matt Hudson, Chief Ranger and Deputy Superintendent of the Obed Wild and Scenic River, will be giving a short program on the park. Located in Morgan County, the Obed Wild and Scenic River is a small park operated by the National Park Service. Though small in size the Obed offers many opportunities for nature photographers.
