Our presenter this month is Len Rue, Jr. Len's program is titled "Animal Photography." This informative lecture on animal photography is a culmination of almost 40 years of wildlife photography while photographing for the publication markets. Animal Photography shows some of his best photographic work taken over the decades at prime photo locations all over the world. This a how-to lecture that covers such topics as equipment used, destinations visited, photo techniques used, and animal behavior. The images presented would be enjoyable for the non-photographer as well.

The name Rue has been synonymous with wildlife photography for over 60 years. Len's father, Lenny, was one of the first successful professional wildlife photographers and is also the most published nature photographer ever. Today, Len Jr. carries on the family tradition and has established himself as a premier nature photographer in his own right.

BIO (from Len)

I have an international reputation in my chosen specialty of nature/wildlife photography. For over 40 years, my photos have been published in hundreds of different publications worldwide, including *Field & Stream*, *Sports Afield*, *Outdoor Life*, *Natural History Magazine*, *National Wildlife*, *Ranger Rick*, *Newsweek*, *New York Times Magazine*, *Peterson's Hunting*, *Cosmopolitan*, *Maxim*, *Reader's Digest*, *Outdoor Photographer*, and *National Geographic*. My photo work has also been used in numerous national ads and brochures, books, calendars, cards and various educational products. I have extensively traveled worldwide photographing for my stock photo business.

My years of photographic field experience have given me a distinctive photographic style and knowledge of both my craft and wildlife and nature. I have a degree in Professional Photography from Rochester Institute of Technology and a Master of Education Degree in Instructional Technology from East Stroudsburg University of Pennsylvania. My experiences and training make me eminently well qualified to lead photo tours, conduct photo workshops and to teach at the higher education level.

For over twenty-five years, I have led photo tours to various North American locations, as well as to Africa, Australia, and South America. I currently lead photographic tours throughout the year for Joseph VanOs Photo Safaris. I give lectures on photography and teach photographic workshops nationwide. For many years, in conjunction with my father, Leonard Lee Rue III, I co-taught an all-day nature photographic seminar that we

presented around the country. I currently teach credited courses in photography for both the undergraduate and graduate programs as an adjunct professor at East Stroudsburg University of Pennsylvania.

I am the co-author of the book, *How to Photograph Animals in the Wild*, and I also have written magazine articles. I am the business manager of Len Rue Enterprises, LLC, selling stock photos (<http://www.rueimages.com/>), and the director of the L. L. Rue Catalog, an on-line store (<http://www.rue.com/>) which offers specialized photographic equipment for wildlife and nature photographers. I reside with my wife, Joan, in the Pocono Mountain region of Northeastern Pennsylvania.
