New Location for Monthly Meeting

Beginning with the **August 29** meeting, SANP's monthly meetings will be held in the Ramsey Cascades Room of the Watershed Building at Cedar Springs Presbyterian Church, located at 9132 Kingston Pike.

Our meeting times have not changed, with social time starting at 6:30pm and the meeting starting at 7:00pm. The Watershed Building is located behind the large church building which houses the two sanctuaries and is not visible from Kingston Pike.

This move away from Pellissippi State was made because of economic reasons and will save the club substantial money each year.

Directions to the Watershed Building:

Traveling on Interstate 40/75, take the Cedar Bluff Road exit and travel to Kingston Pike. Turn left at the traffic light onto Kingston Pike. Turn right at the first light into the church parking lot (9132 Kingston Pike). Go to the fourth lane and turn right. The Watershed Building is straight ahead.

Once you enter the main door of the Watershed Building (shown in the photo below), walk straight back to find the Ramsey Cascades Room.

2018 Salon Changes

The SANP Board made the following changes to the Salon categories for the 2018 Salon. A more detailed explanation of Salon rules will be posted on the SANP website this fall. If these changes prove to have a positive effect, they may become permanent.

The digital competition will have two new categories: "People in Nature" and "Abstracts In Nature." These two categories will **not** be eligible for Best of Show. None of the current categories are affected by these additions.

Another change for the digital competition is that members may now enter up to two images per category, for a possible total of 16 images.

The color print competition will now have only four categories: Scenic, Travel, Wildlife, and Everything Else. Members may enter up to two images per category.

The black & white competition will not have specific categories but instead will be judged as one category--an all-in-one category. Members may enter up to four black & white images.
